

2015 Top Ten Seniors Award Application

The Top Ten Seniors Awards are presented annually by the UTEP Alumni Association to UTEP's most promising future alumni. Graduating or recently-graduated seniors are evaluated on a combination of academic achievement, involvement, leadership and service both in the community and on-campus, as well as the impression they have made on others during their time at UTEP. This award reflects the true spirit of what it means to be both an outstanding student and a proud Miner.

To be eligible for consideration, students must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have a minimum cumulative **3.25** grade point average.
- 2. Show sustained involvement, service and leadership on campus and in the community.
- 3. Be an **undergraduate** receiving your first UTEP degree in December 2014, May 2015, or August 2015.
- 4. Provide **three single-page** letters of recommendation from a combination of university faculty or staff, student or civic organization advisors, supervisors or employers each in its own sealed envelope.
- 5. Not be on any academic or disciplinary probation. (A list of applicants will be given to the Office of the Dean of Students for verification).
- 6. Students in five-year masters programs do not meet eligibility for the Top Ten Senior award criteria.

Scoring:

Applicants are evaluated by the Top Ten Senior Awards selection committee based on the following 100 point scale:

•	Academic Achievement	30 points
•	Campus Activities	20 points
•	Community Activities	20 points
•	Essay	20 points
•	Other	10 points

Submit to the UTEP Alumni Relations by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, February 6, 2015.

Applications received after the deadline cannot be accepted.
