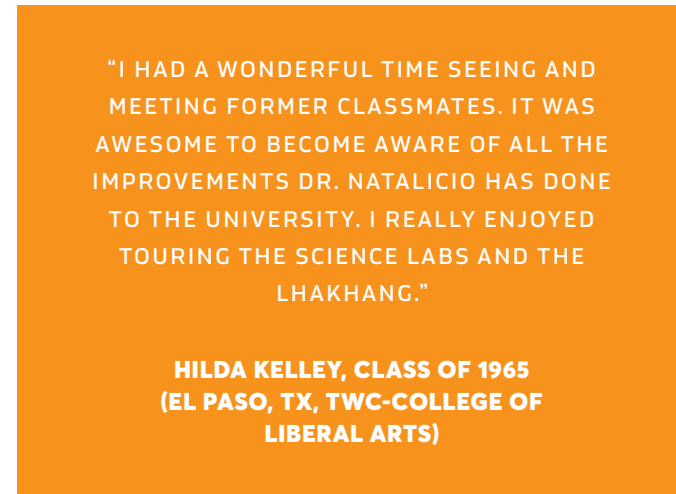
THINGS TO DO WHILE VISITING UTEP
