Miner Ambassador Application:

Miner Ambassadors are a group of students who represent UTEP and serve as official hosts at University events. Miner Ambassadors are selected based on a rigid set of criteria and serve for at least two years.

Applications are due by 5 p.m. on **Monday, November 19, 2018**, to the Office of Alumni Relations in the Peter and Margaret de Wetter Center. Please use the PDF form to type application.

To be eligible for consideration, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Have and maintain a minimum **3.2** grade point average
2. Be enrolled full-time at UTEP and maintain full-time status throughout your time as a Miner Ambassador
3. Be in good standing with the University at all times during your time as a Miner Ambassador
4. Submit a complete application and a 500 word statement (typed) as to why you would like to be a Miner Ambassador
5. Show involvement, service, and leadership, on campus and/or in the community
6. Provide a resume and three (3) references (forms attached to application-you may duplicate)
7. Commit to serving for two academic years
8. **Attend a mandatory three-day training session. Training for Miner Ambassadors will be on August 20-22.** Fall Semester classes start on August 26th.
9. Attend required monthly meetings
