Applications are due by 5 p.m. on Monday, November 14, 2016, to the Office of Alumni Relations in the Peter and Margaret de Wetter Center. Please type application in 12 point font.

To be eligible for consideration, students must meet the following criteria:

1. Have a minimum **3.2** grade point average
2. Submit this application and a 500 word statement as to why you would like to be a Miner Ambassador
3. Show involvement, service, and leadership, on campus and/or in the community
4. Provide three (3) references (forms attached to application)
5. Provide a resume
6. Commit to serving for two consecutive academic years
7. Attend a three-day training session held the week before school starts in August
8. Attend required monthly meetings
